

ST. MARY, QUEEN OF ANGELS
FINANCE COUNCIL MINUTES
07/22/2025

Attendance	Fr. Michael Elanjimattathil, David Beagley, Mark Ptacek, Jim Malone, John Malone and Jane Cline were in attendance. The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m.
Financials	Marcia Blundon was in attendance to address questions on the financial statement. Finance Council members reviewed, approved, and signed the 2024-2025 financial report. Consensus of the Council was to roll the 2024-2025 budget forward to the 2026-2027 year and make needed adjustments to compensate for salary increases. Discussion was held on the need to authorize a credit card for the parish to make online purchases and pay bills. The Council unanimously agreed to set a \$10,000 limit on the card and list the office staff as signers. St. Mary Queen of Angels was bequeathed \$250,000 in memory of Fred Weigel. The funds were invested into a Certificate of Deposit.
Stone	Fr. Michael reported the contract with Mid-Continent Restoration, Inc. to refurbish the stone on the exterior of the church has been signed by Bishop Vincke. Duke Strobel has scheduled the work to begin in September/October 2025.
Salaries	The Council reached a consensus to approve a \$1.00 per hour pay increase for all employees.
Parking Lot	The parking lot sealing and striping work has been completed. However, concerns have been raised regarding the quality of the crack sealing and the painting of the light pillars. John Malone has agreed to contact the contractor to discuss these issues further and seek clarification or potential remediation.
Adjournment	The meeting adjourned at 5:57 p.m.
