FINANCE COUNCIL MINUTES

- Attendance** Fr. Daryl Olmstead, David Beagley, Jim Malone, John Malone, Mark Ptacek, and Jane Cline were in attendance. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.
- Parking Lot** John Antrim from Stipe 'N' Seal was in attendance to discuss the outstanding payment for work done on the parking lot. Council members expressed displeasure with services performed. Discussion followed where a compromise was reached for Mr. Antrim to return to complete the work as outlined in the original bid prior to receiving the final payment. Council members will mark the areas of the parking lot in need of attention before Mr. Antrim returns to the job site.
- Financials** The Council reviewed the September 2025 balance sheet. No questions were raised.
- Stonework** Mid-Continent Restoration is on site and performing the needed stonework on the exterior of the church and parish center. Work is expected to continue for two more weeks.
- Custodial Wages** Discussion was held on the custodian's hourly wage. Jim Malone made a motion to give Bruce Heier a \$2.00 per hour raise. The motion passed unanimously.
- Maintenance Employee** The Parish Council expressed interest in hiring a maintenance employee. Consensus of the Finance Council was to advertise the position in the church bulletin.
- Snow Removal** Mark Ptacek reported Dustin Dreher is willing to assist with snow removal this winter. Discussion was held on whether the parish snow blower is operational. Mark will visit with Dustin to determine whether the snow blower works or if it needs to be replaced.
- Adjournment** The meeting adjourned at 7:14 p.m.
