Minutes of the Meeting of February 6, 2019

The regular monthly meeting of the St. Mary Queen of Angels Pastoral Council was held on Tuesday, February 5th, at 7:00 pm in the conference room in the parish hall. Father Michael and the following members were present: Leon Weigel, Cindy Balthazor, Bruce Heier, Sandy Ochampaugh, Tricia Flax, George Bray, John Ogle, Coleen Boxberger, and Chris Sipe.

Tricia led us in our opening prayer. The minutes of the last meeting were read and were approved.

Financial Council: Father Michael reported that we are still in the black. Entrance door work will start soon, going to be a regular size door and cost will be almost \$12,000.00. Parish Hall repair is going on and it may take a few more weeks to complete. Looking at different options to improve the lighting in the parking lot – LED, Dusk to Day. In the summer months we may do maintenance work in the parking lot including restriping of the spaces. We got more shelving for the parish hall basement and everything is well organized. Will have a Finance Council meeting the end of the month or early part of the next month. The Finance Council will discuss about the security plan and procedures in their next meeting.

Stewardship: Coleen reported that there is a Stewardship Conference being held in Wichita on February 20-21 Wichita, KS. Tricia moved that we pay for the expenses for Coleen to go and Bruce seconded. The vote was unanimous to cover Colleens cost to go to this conference.

Coleen reported on the #iGiveCatholic online campaign. We raised \$21,210.00 for our parish. \$8,290 of that total is a donation of matching funds that was made available to the Salina Diocese for #iGiveCatholic.

Knights: Chris reported that the pancake feed for Father Grennan's Birthday served 80 people. The local free throw competition had 14 shooters, 9 went on to district. Knights and Shriners fed 42 people for stag night. The Knights Funnel Cakes that were sold during the Christmas parade and Weihnachtsfest – half of the money made from this was given to the food pantry. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Degree -- we are having it here on February 17th.

RCCW: Sandy reported they would be meeting on Thursday night February 7th. They will be talking about making Easter bags again for the nursing homes. Valentines cards will be handed out this weekend after

mass. Sandy also wanted to recognize Patty for all she has done. Father Grennan and Father Michael donated some of their used Mass vestments and Patty had them cleaned. They are being sent to Africa and India to aid priests without vestments. Patty also reported that the rosary committee has sent 300 rosaries to Ft. Sill, OK; 600 rosaries to Ft. Hood, Texas; 300 to JBSA Fort Houston, TX; and 600 rosaries to Ft. Benning, GA, 1800 total.

New Business: A concern was brought to the parish council about the parking lines being hard to see in the parking lot. This question was answered in the financial report.

Our next meeting will be held on March 5th at 7:00 pm.
